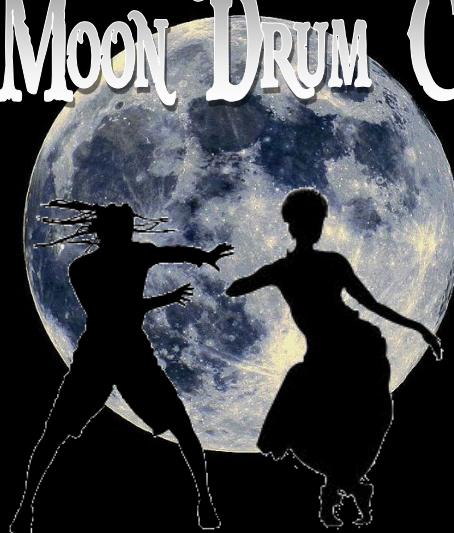

HOW TO GET TO

SHAMBHALA ECO-CASTLE?

The easiest way is by bus from
Kathmandu or Pokhara to Butwal
(Rs.800/-, 8 hours), and a second
bus from Butwal to Chakla,
Arghakhachi (Rs.250/-, 3 hours).
From Chakla, you can either walk
into Harre (11 km), or there is a jeep
once a day at 3pm (Rs.150/-). From
Harre, follow the signs to Shanti,
Kranti, or Keiki Castles (2km hike).
